PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE 1970 ILLINOIS CONSTITUTION

This proposal grants the state the authority to impose higher income tax rates on higher income levels, which is how the federal government and a majority of other states do it. It would remove the portion of the Revenue Article that is referred to as the “flat tax” that requires all taxes on income to be at the same rate. It gives the State the ability to impose higher tax rates on those with higher income levels and lower income tax levels on those with lower incomes.
